July Greetings!

We are so pleased to tell you that we are finding more creative ways to meet in person with the blessing of our Outdoor facility! Beginning in July, we will have our Outdoor shelter available for people to gather safely in a small group. Primarily, this will be for Communion Circles, so that we can have a group of ten or less, meet

together in conversation, prayer, and to have Holy Communion in an outdoor environment with one of our pastors. These Communion Circles will be offered several times a week in place of Bible Study in hopes that our regular Outdoor or Online worship will be enriched with these face to face gatherings. The Smart Team that's been designated to work through all Covid 19 protocols and procedures for CLC, has been working to put guidelines in place for all small group gatherings at our Outdoor Space. The gatherings will take place under the shelter to protect from rain and intense sun, and we hope to have a wind shield up soon too. While we will be outdoors and striving to maintain the proper distance of six feet at all times, face coverings are never a bad idea and a way to protect those with whom we are meeting. There will be a host at these outdoor gatherings that knows the guidelines for the Communion Circles and other small group gatherings that will make sure guidelines are followed and teach the leader these procedures for ongoing groups, such as each person wiping down their own chair and putting it back, before they leave the space, etc.

If you would like to be a part of a Communion Circle in July or would like to sign up a church ministry group to meet at the Outdoor space in July, please see the details for how to do so further on in the newsletter.

As I write this letter, this newsletter will be sent before our big congregational meeting on the last Sunday in June; but nevertheless, I can still say how thankful I am for our congregation and the generous hearts and hands that we will celebrate at that meeting! How incredible it is, that in the middle of a pandemic we can come together to celebrate how God works to enable us to build a new roof by the end of the year. Of course, we are grateful for the generosity of all who have donated to make that roof a reality; and we're also celebrating all the generous hearts and hands that carry out all the mission and ministry that Christ calls us to do through our facility – all the "God's work. Hello Crosslake Lutheran Faith Community,

The Jesus style innovating continues as we let that powerful Holy Spirit keep breathing possibility into our ministries. Here are some updates on several areas of our children, youth and family ministries.

### CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILY NEWS

VBS Because of safety precautions we cannot hold our VBS/Daycamp in our normal way at the outdoor site. But just like us, the staff and counselors at Luther Crest have also been letting that Holy Spirit work too and have launched a program called "Bold Transformational Faith" or "BTF". This means that Daycamp/VBS will be coming into your houses! You can pick your week of either August 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> or August 10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>. If you can safely do it, you might even want to partner together with another family and have a multi-family VBS/Daycamp experience.

Each day of camp will have a variety of components including pre-recorded videos for your day camper including worships, songfest, arts and crafts, and game ideas to play with their family. There will also be evening Zoom Bible Dives with a camp counselor that your whole family can join in. Supply kits for the crafts and activities are being assembled at Luther Crest and will be mailed to each camper. The theme for the summer is **Go! Make Disciples!** Based on the Great Commission in Matthew 28. **Look for more detailed information and registration to be coming to your email and mailbox soon!**

Pastor Kurt will be connecting with each of the fifth graders and parents to find a couple common dates and times in July and/or August so that we can have First Communion classes in the outdoor worship shelter space!
